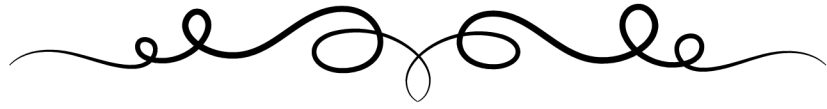

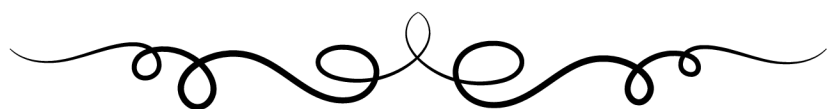


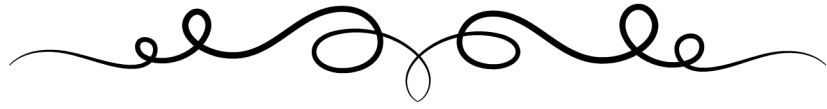
One: The Wrong Door

3. What can be said about their adventures and how they came to be? Who is "their"?

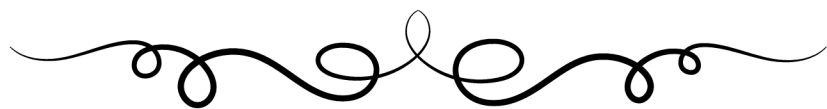


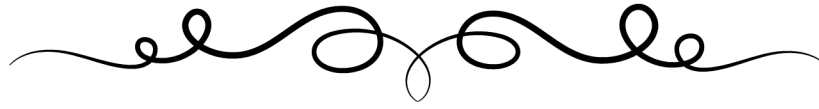


4. Digory states “Grown-ups are always thinking of uninteresting explanations”. Do you agree? Does that resonate? What would be the reason for adults to react that way?
